- Soft-spike golf or flat-soled shoes are required.
- All players must remain fully clothed at all times.
- Please repair your pitch marks, divots and all other blemishes done onto the turf.
- Please rake and repair bunkers when rakes are present.
- Private coolers are not permitted on the Golf Course.
- Golf Carts must be kept 30' from all greens and tee boxes, unless on the cart path.
- For your safety, Golf Carts must be kept out of all native and/or clearly unmaintained areas of the Golf Course.

## LOCAL RULES & KNOWLEDGE

- All yardage markers are to the center of the green.
- Out-of-Bounds is defined by White Stakes and/or Perimeter Fencing. DO NOT play from these areas.
- All water, native and clearly unmaintained areas of the Golf Course are Penalty Areas.
- All Bunkers on the Golf Course are Waste Areas.
